

2021 TRI-COMMUNITY COED VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE RULES & REGULATIONS

The League's objective is to provide Recreational Volleyball in a safe, controlled and fun atmosphere. We started this League in 2019, with COVID-19 we could not host a 2nd annual in 2020. We are happy to be able to run the league this fall! This year we will be adding mandatory masks and proof of vaccination passports or a recent covid-19 negative test result.

Start Date: October 5th, 2021

Team Fee: \$300

End Date: December 2nd, 2021

Registration:

- Contact Nichole Charles to register your team by October 1st, 2021.

Team Reps:

- One team Rep per team is required; team Reps are responsible to let their teammates know about information and game rules and times.
- Team Rep is to submit a contact phone number
- If a game is to be rescheduled team Rep must contact the opposing team and contact Nichole. More information on the Rescheduling Games Section.

Team Size & Final Roster:

- 6 players including a minimum of 2 girls on the court. Teams may play with 4 players but cannot sub a male for a female.
- Minimum of 4 players to play the game; you lose one point each time the “missing” player is up to serve.
- 8 player max on the roster. FINAL rosters to be submitted on October 29th, 2021.
- No adding or switching teams after October 29th, 2021.
- An individual cannot be on 2 different rosters.

Games & Times:

- Game days will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays, starting on October 5th, 2021
- Start time will be at 7:30pm
- The first set is a forfeit if a team does not have enough players to play 10 minutes after the scheduled game time.
- The second set is a forfeit if a team does not have enough players 20 minutes after the scheduled game time.
- Should you cancel without contacting Nichole or Team Rep from the opposing team your game will be considered a loss.

Game Play:

- Rally point system. 2 sets up to 25 points, win by 2 no 3rd set will be applied.
- Number of wins will be based on games won, if a tie at the end of the league then total of game points will be added to determine playoff draw.
- Regular Volleyball rules apply, unless otherwise stated in the rules or noted. See Volleyball Canada Rule Book.

Officiating:

- All games (except for playoffs) are self-officiated.
- Players are responsible to make their own calls and keep their own score.
- Teams should play fairly and call their own fouls. Be honest.
- Any reckless, aggressive, threatening or unsportsmanlike behavior will be asked to leave. The player will be given 3 warnings. If this behavior is repeated the player will be suspended from the game.

Rescheduling Games:

- Rescheduling games will be for those who have contacted Nichole 3 hours prior to your scheduled game time.
- Team Reps are responsible for communicating with the opposing team rep and both team reps agree to reschedule.
- We will have 2 weeks in December to do some make-up games.

Play-Offs:

- Play-offs will be held on December 18th, 2021, if this date does not work for most teams then we will have it in January 2022.
- Players MUST have played 5 league games in order to play in playoffs.
- Reminder; play fair, it is a recreational league. 😊
